Entry Rules:

2. Entries must not have been published elsewhere. Evidence of prior publication of any entry will disqualify it.
3. Each contestant is limited to two entries per Tropic Lightning values category.
4. Entries may be 300 dpi digital photos, black-and-white prints or color prints. Photographs must not be tinted or altered. (Send digital photos to divisionretentionoffice@hawaii.army.mil or drop-off at Bldg. 585 Trimble Rd.)
5. The minimum size for prints is 5x7 inches; the maximum is 8x10 inches (no mats or frames).
6. A sheet of paper must be taped to the back of each entry with the following information: the photographer's name, Rank, Unit, email address, telephone number, and values depicted.
7. Name of winners and winning photo will be published on the 25th ID website.
8. Entries will not be returned.
9. Division Retention or Career Counselors are not eligible to enter.
10. Chosen photographs may be published in other Tropic Lightning publications.
11. Photographic quality and subject matter will be the primary considerations in judging.
12. Entry constitutes waiver of copyrights.
13. Deadline for submission is 1 September.
