

3. Prior to your arrival, you should make reservations with the Inn at Schofield Barracks (808-642-9650). If they are unable to accommodate you, the Inn at Schofield Barracks will fax you a Statement of Non-Availability (SNA) and a list of authorized alternate locations. You will need an SNA prior to choosing alternate lodging or you may be limited in the amount you'll be reimbursed for travel. When you arrive at the Honolulu Airport, please sign in with the 25th Infantry Division Replacement Detachment desk located between baggage claim areas F and G. You will need your orders and leave form.

4. The state of Hawaii is comprised of eight main islands, with the largest portion of the population located here on O'ahu. Hawaii has a lot to offer and you will be greatly encouraged to enjoy as much as you can.
