## SCHOOLS

### GENERAL

The Following records are required when a child first registers for school in Hawaii:

- Birth Certificate
- Certificate of Release and Proficiency from the last school attended
- Current documented TB clearance
- Complete series of immunizations (i.e., DTP, MMR, Poliomyelitis)

An "A+", after-school, program is available to public elementary students at affordable rates for grades K through 6 from approximate 2:00 pm to 5:30 pm.

**Your residential district determines the public school that your children will attend. For Army families, you could be assigned to housing in any of 6 different communities; therefore, you will not know which schools your children will be attending until your quarters have been assigned.**

### SPECIAL SERVICES

**The Hawaii ACS EFMP recommends that all parents of special education children access the Hawaii State Department of Education website and Chapter 56, which governs our public schools, at <http://doe.k12.hi.us/specialeducation/chapter56/56tableofcontents.htm> to become familiar with state laws. ACS EFMP offers a FREE IEP workshop series, through their partnership with the Learning Disabilities of Hawaii, throughout the year. We strongly recommend all parents of children with special education needs attend this workshop series.**

- Individualized Education Program (IEP)
- IQ test scores and profiles
- Academic/Achievement test scores and profiles
- Speech/language evaluations
- PT/OT reports
- Medical/developmental data
- Psychological/Psychiatric reports

**Special Education programs** in Hawaii are in compliance with PL 94-142 and Hawaii State chapter 36. FAPE (free and public education) is offered to all eligible students.

**Hawaii schools honor** special education certificates from former school districts on an interim basis.

When a student transfers from out of state, the IEP team will need to conduct an initial evaluation. Existing data (e.g. assessment data / information / IEP) from the previous setting may be used to determine eligibility.

Per the memo from the Hawaii school's superintendent on October 10, 2002, the mainland IEP can be implemented while the initial evaluation is being conducted. Each state determines their own eligibility criteria, therefore, eligibility must be determined in accordance with the criteria set by the State of Hawaii.
