

## **BADGES ON COMBAT UNIFORMS**

- Personnel may wear up to five badges above the U.S. Army tape so long as space allows for the badges on the individual's uniform.
- Personnel may only wear one combat or special skill badge from either group 1 or group 2. Group 1 and 2 badges cannot be worn together. Soldiers may wear up to five badges from groups 3 and 4.
- Worn in order of group precedence, from top to bottom and from the wearer's right to left.
- When one, two, or three badges are worn, they are centered 1/8 inch above the U.S. Army tape and worn vertically with 1/4 inch between badges.
- When four badges are worn, they are centered 1/8 inch above the U.S. Army tape, and worn vertically and side-by side in stacks of two with 1/4 inch between badges vertically and 1/2 inch between badges horizontally.
- When five badges are worn, they are worn the same as four badges with the additional badge centered 1/4 inch above the top two badges.
